Do you have trouble understanding things on television?

Do you have trouble understanding the speaker in a large room such as at a meeting or a place of worship?

If you answered **YES** to one or more of these questions, you should have your hearing checked by a hearing specialist.

Your Hearing Health Care Program

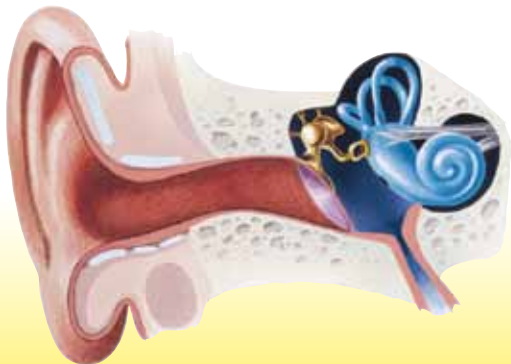
In Australia, 1 in 10 people suffer from hearing loss. It is recommended that you have a hearing assessment every 2 years over the age of 45 years.

Good Hearing

Good hearing starts helping us even before birth. When we have good hearing, we have security in noisy situations such as traffic. We learn to speak and understand words when we have good hearing. Good hearing means we can appreciate the intonations in music and the emotions of a loved one.

Hearing Loss

Hearing loss is generally a slow process that takes place over time. Because of this, people can have difficulty recognizing and accepting their hearing loss. Hearing loss often makes it difficult to “keep up”, which can lead to a sense of isolation, fatigue and loneliness.



1. Contact Us

- Arrange an appointment for a hearing assessment
- We will assess if you are eligible for free hearing services under the Australian Government Hearing Services Voucher System and help you fill out the relevant forms

2. See your local doctor

- It is recommended to see your local doctor before your hearing assessment to check for earwax

3. Hearing Assessment

- We will perform a comprehensive hearing assessment
- This will be followed by an in-depth discussion about the options for your hearing
 - Your listening needs, goals and expectations are discussed
- If necessary, hearing aids will be prescribed

4. Hearing Aid Fitting

- Your hearing aids are tested and fitted using the latest verification and testing procedures
 - You are shown how to use and care for your hearing aids
- The process of adjusting to your hearing aids is discussed and a personal program is implemented



5. Follow Up Appointments

- We will adjust your hearing aids according to your experiences and comments
 - It usually takes some time to adjust to wearing hearing aids, so there may be a need for more than one follow up appointment (there is no charge for these appointments)

6. On Going Care

- Appointments are made as required if there are any problems with your hearing aids
 - Cleaning or repairs of hearing aids
 - Provision of hearing aid batteries
 - Annual hearing health check-ups
